The First Week in Your New FIRE Class

Meet and Greet

Teachers have been asked not to let students travel on Tuesday, 2/19, and not to hold interventions that day, either. The class should meet for attendance & for a teacher welcome/introduction.

FIRE Crew leaders need to talk with their FIRE teacher to discuss roles & responsibilities.

Rules, Expectations and Guidelines

Tuesday is a chance for the teacher & FIRE Crew leaders to review with the class the classroom rules, behavior expectations and guidelines for working and traveling in the FIRE advisory period.

Seating Assignments and Materials

Evenly divide and assign the enrolled FIRE students amongst the FIRE Crew leaders. Each group should be seated in CLOSE proximity to the front of the room on the pod-side. FIRE Crew leaders should SIT with their groups during FIRE.

Review of FIRE Crew Leader Daily/Weekly Duties

- ☞ Make sure kids are seated as assigned.
- ☞ Ask for and review student agendas for due dates and project timelines.
- ☞ Review and sign travel passes – check up...
- ☞ Set up a tracking form for travelers – check up on them randomly...
- ☞ Complete random materials and binder checks daily.
- ☞ Talk with each student weekly about grades, assignments, projects, challenges.
- ☞ Use the Weekly Action Plan for struggling students – help them get organized.
- ☞ FIRE Crew should talk with the FIRE teacher daily – ask him/her to help you facilitate your FIRE students.
- ☞ Role model appropriate study behaviors.

Remember...the students assigned to FIRE for semester 2 are most likely struggling in two or more classes. Many have Ds or Fs in multiple subjects. These kids need your assistance, even when they do not act like it.
